




Public Consultation No. 1 Concept and Feasibility

Introduction

Cork County Council are in the early stages of developing a Greenway between Crossbarry, Bandon and Clonakilty with a link to Timoleague. This project, which is funded by Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII), will provide a Greenway servicing the Bandon, Clonakilty and Timoleague hinterlands. RPS have been appointed by Cork County Council to provide multi-disciplinary consultancy services to progress the project through the design and planning stages, following Phases 1-4 of the TII Project Management Guidelines.



Support and facilitate the implementation of national, regional and local sustainable transport policies.



Safety

Provide safe and accessible infrastructure, which improves the safety and security for vulnerable road users and landowners.

Increase public appreciation of the natural environment and local heritage, while protecting and enhancing natural assets and biodiversity.






Bandon Clonakilty Timoleague
